- **2 page (max.), single-spaced research proposal.** Your research must be clearly related to the study of social movements. In your proposal, you must state how you expect your research to contribute to social movement scholarship.
- **Detailed budget with justification for costs.** The grant covers travel to field sites for ethnographic research as well as to libraries, other archives, and training centers.
